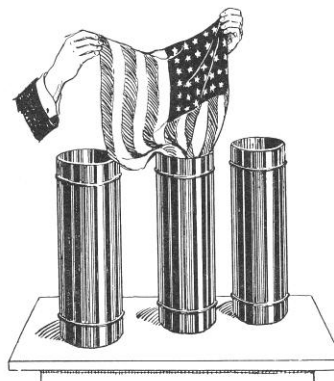

He laid into The Amazing Jonathon and Penn and Teller, stating that he cannot stomach how they present magic in the crude way they do and that we should, as magicians, not be vulgar or use foul language or concepts.

What a very nice man he is...and Tammy...and what an experience for me to be there. I felt honored to be there. At the OMC...and here is John Calvert...in person...up close with all his history.

I joined the club last night. Thanks again for getting me to see Calvert...I am still floating from the experience.
