Prize Increases for the OMC!

At the May OMC Board Meeting it was decided to increase the monetary awards at the three annual contests.

1. For the June Lloyd Jones Memorial Close-Up Contest first prize is increased from \$50 to \$75. (OMC members only, 6-12 minute act).
2. At the August Stage Competition first prize is increased from zero to \$75. (OMC members only, 8-12 minute act).
3. At the September Inter-Club Stage Competition the temporary increase from \$100 to \$150 is made permanent. (Each contestant to represent a greater Bay Area magic club, 8-12 minute act). The winner also has the opportunity to perform at the February Installation Banquet for an additional \$150.

The usual rules apply to all three contests – the previous year's winner is not eligible to compete and no open flame or material unsuitable for a family audience.

Members were anxiously waiting to learn the identity of the handsome young magician performing Zombie pictured in the May Bulletin. For the benefit of the unfortunate members not able to attend, it was your Historian, Fred Casto. Members were encouraged to secretly submit their youthful photos of them performing magic to your President or Secretary, who jointly slave over each Bulletin. The second reading for membership of Doug Kovacich was given and he was voted into membership. The meeting was adjourned at 7:30 PM, followed by two lectures. The first was by Richard Halle, who spoke on using the voice effectively. We have Ken Taylor to thank for arranging this lecture. The second talk was by Ric Ewing, who discussed how to analyze a magical effect to increase its impact on an audience.
